

The European EuroVelo 6 cycling route connects the Atlantic Ocean and Black Sea in the west-east direction passing through Serbia along the Danube course and it is therefore called the Danube Cycling Route. It enters into Serbia from Hungary at Bački Breg, passes through Sombor, Novi Sad, Belgrade, Pančevo, Djerdap Gorge and Negotin and from there it crosses into Bulgaria. The track through Serbia is 1,040 km long - the main route is 668 km long while the alternative routes are 370 km long. The track base is made of dirt or macadam (the parts passing through nature enclosures), or asphalt where cyclists share the public road with cars and trucks. The entire route is well marked while road signs and signalisation on the route are harmonised with signalisation in other countries. There are printed maps, tourist guide for cyclists and internet page. This is the only route within the EuroVelo system in Serbia that satisfies the basic standards for adequate bicycle traffic.

## **EUROVELO 6 - DANUBE ROUTE**



The Danube route passes through the territory of the City of Novi Sad following the left bank of the Danube. The main route stretches along the Danube embankment and Sunčani kej, while the alternative route leads along Futoški Put, Jevrejska Street and Bulevar Mihajla Pupina. Both routes merge at Varadin Rainbow Bridge and cross over to the Srem side passing through Petrovaradin towards Sremski Karlovci

# **BIKE AND TRAIN**






